

## PREDGOVOR

Pred nama je peti broj časopisa *Historijski pogledi*. Rezultat je to kontinuiranog rada Centra za istraživanje moderne i savremene historije Tuzla. Bez obzira na otežane uslove rada, istraživanja i pisanje radova, usljed pandemije izazvane pojavom korona virusa, autori i Redakcija su uložili maksimalne napore da se štampa ovaj broj Časopisa. Osim toga, Redakcija se trudila da Časopis, zbog otežanih uslova rada, ne izgubi na kvalitetu. Da je kvalitet Časopisa neosporan potvrđuje i činjenica da je isti indeksiran u 27 međunarodnih naučnih baza, te da su od ovoga broja svi radovi u DOI sistemu.

Peti broj časopisa *Historijski pogledi* sadrži rubrike Članci, Prikazi i Izvještaji. Osim toga, dati su i Popis publikacija štampanih u izdanju Centra za istraživanje moderne i savremene historije Tuzla, te Upute autorima.

Rubrika *Članci* sadrži 13 radova, rubrika *Prikazi* pet radova, a rubrika *Izvještaji* jedan rad. U Časopisu je, dakle, objavljeno 19 radova. Svi radovi su recenzirani i kategorizirani.

Autori radova su iz Republike Poljske, Republike Bugarske, Republike Crne Gore, te Bosne i Hercegovine. Objavljeni radovi tretiraju važna pitanja iz moderne i savremene historije.

U rubrici *Članci* objavljeni su radovi koji tretiraju slijedeća istraživačka pitanja: Granice i spone: Mali Zvornik i Sakar u tokovima deosmanizacije Balkana XIX i XX stoljeća (Safet Bandžović); Proces uvakufljenja vakufa tuzlanske dobrotvorke Tahire-hanume Tuzlić (Izet Šabotić); Emancipacija žena u Bosni i Hercegovini u vrijeme austrougarske uprave (1878-1918) (Tomasz Jacek Lis); Prilog istraživanju položaja i aktivnosti radničkog pokreta u Bosni i Hercegovini od završetka Prvog svjetskog rata do početka Husinske bune (Denis Bećirović); „Uz Tita i Partiju“. Djelatnost Antifašističkog fronta žena Bosne i Hercegovine i njihove reakcije na propagandu Informbiroa tokom 1948. i 1949. godine (Jasmin Jajčević); Albanci u Jugoslaviji od kraja 60-ih do početka 80-ih XX stoljeća (Marijana Stamoja); Transformacija države i prava u Iranu nakon Iranske revolucije 1979. godine (Sead Bandžović); Društveni i stranački rascjepi u Bosni i Hercegovini poslije izbora 1990. godine (Amir Ahmetović); Vlasenica od 1991. do 2013. godine: Promjene u etničkoj strukturi stanovništva pod utjecajem rata protiv Republike Bosne i Hercegovine (Sead Selimović); Neki aspekti djelovanja vojske Jugoslavije u agresiji na Republiku Bosnu i Hercegovinu na području srednjeg Podrinja početkom 1993. godine (Mesud Šadinlija); Procesuiranje u predmetu Radovan Karadžić - ICTY IT-95-5/18 (Meldijana Arnaut Haseljić); Identitet i samostid - Kako to izgleda kod Bošnjaka. Prilog razumijevanju nekih karakteristika nacionalne svijesti kod Bošnjaka (Adib Đozić); Prilozi o prošlosti Bosne i Hercegovine u turskoj historiografskoj periodici (2010-2020) (Lamija Hatibović, Amer Maslo).

Autori su odabrali aktuelne i važne teme. Do rezultata istraživanja, koje su vrlo jasno prikazali, došli su koristeći historijske izvore različite

provenijencije. Osim toga, autori su u svojim radovima donijeli fusnote i time omogućili provjerljivost što i jeste jedno od obilježja znanstvenog rada.

Rubrika *Prikazi* sadrži izdanja štampana 2019. i 2020. godine. Predstavljeno je pet knjiga čiji su autori Dženita Sarač-Rujanac, Filip Škiljan, Asmir Crnković – Mirza Ahmetbašić, Admir Adrović i Zajim Kruško.

U rubrici *Izveštaji*, Jasmin Jajčević predstavio je Izvještaj sa Naučne manifestacije „Historijski pogledi 3“, koja je održana u Tuzli, 19. novembar 2020. godine.

Zahvaljujemo se svim autorima radova, saradnicima, kolegama, prijateljima i donatorima koji su zaslužni za štampanje petog broja *Historijskih pogleda*. ## FOREWORD

Before us is the fifth issue of the journal *Historical Views*. This is the result of the continuous work of the Center for Research of Modern and Contemporary History Tuzla. Despite the difficult working conditions, research and writing of papers, due to the pandemic caused by the appearance of the corona virus, the authors and the Editorial Board made every effort to print this issue of the Journal. In addition, the Editorial Board tried not to lose the quality of the Journal due to the difficult working conditions. That the quality of the Journal is indisputable is confirmed by the fact that it is indexed in 27 international scientific databases, and that of this number, all papers are in the DOI system.

The fifth issue of the journal *Historical Views* contains the sections *Articles*, *Reviews* and *Conference Reports*. In addition, a list of publications published by the Center for Research in Modern and Contemporary History Tuzla and Instructions to Authors are provided.

The *Articles* section contains 13 papers, the *Reviews* section five papers, and the *Conference Reports* section one contribution. Therefore, 19 papers were published in the Journal. All papers are reviewed and categorized.

The authors of the papers are from the Republic of Poland, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Republic of Montenegro and Bosnia and Herzegovina. Published papers address important issues in modern and contemporary history.

In the section *Articles*, published papers address the following research issues: Borders and bonds: Mali Zvornik and Sakar during the deosmanization of the Balkans of the XIX and XX century (Safet Bandžović); The procedure of the Waqf formation by Tuzla's beneficiary Tahira-hanuma Tuzlić (Izet Šabotić); Emancipation of Women in Bosnia and Herzegovina during the austro-hungarian administration (1878-1918) (Tomasz Jacek Lis); Contribution to Research of the position and activity of Labour movements in Bosnia and Herzegovina since the end of the First World War until the beginning of the Husin Rebellion (Denis Bećirović); "With Tito and the Party". Activity of the women's Anti-fascist front Bosnia and Herzegovina and their reactions on the Informbiro propanganda during 1948 and 1949 (Jasmin Jajčević); The Albanians in Yugoslavia from the late 1960s to the early 1980s (Mariyana StamoVA); Transformation of the State and Law in Iran after the Iranian Revolution in 1979 (Sead Bandžović); Social and political divisions in Bosnia and Herzegovina after the 1990 elections (Amir Ahmetović); Vlasenica from 1991 to 2013: Changes in the ethnic structure of the population under the influence of the war against the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Sead Selimović); Some aspects of activity of the Army of Yugoslavia in the aggression against Republic Bosnia and Herzegovina on the territory of Central Podrinje in the beginning of 1993 (Mesud Šadinlija); Prosecution in the

Radovan Karadzic case – ICTY IT-95-5/18 (Meldijana Arnaut Haseljić); Identity and shame – How it seems from Bosniaks perspective. A contribution to the understanding of some characteristics of the national consciousness among Bosniaks (Adib Dozić); Contributions about the past of Bosnia and Herzegovina in Turkish historiographic periodics (2010-2020) (Lamija Hatibović, Amer Maslo).

The authors have chosen current and important topics. The results of the research, which they presented very clearly, were obtained using historical sources of different provenance. In addition, the authors brought footnotes in their works and thus enabled verifiability, which is one of the features of scientific work.

The *Reviews* section contains editions printed in 2019 and 2020. Five books were presented by Dženita Sarač-Rujanac, Filip Škiljan, Asmir Crnkić - Mirza Ahmetbašić, Admir Adrović and Zajim Kruško.

In the *Conference Reports* section, Jasmin Jajčević presented the Report from the Scientific Event „Historical Views 3”, which was held in Tuzla, on November 19, 2020.

We thank all the authors, contributors, colleagues, friends and donors who are credited with printing the fifth issue of Historical Views. We invite fellow historians, and scientists and experts from related sciences to cooperate, to contribute their articles from modern and contemporary history to the publication of future issues of the journal. The sixth issue of the journal *Historical Views* will be printed by November 2021.
